Transforming Our Mainstreet

The Mainstreet Precinct Upgrade will see the heart of Victor Harbor's Town Centre transformed into a vibrant public space that celebrates the town's character, encourages more activity and improves the links with other areas of the town centre. The seven stage upgrade will be undertaken over a number of years, and is based on a framework outlined within the council's Victor Harbor Mainstreet Precinct Master Plan.

Following the successful completion of Stage One in 2016, Stage Two construction works will start in May 2019.

Stage Two Details

Stage Two of the Victor Harbor Mainstreet Precinct Upgrade extends along Ocean Street from the Torrens Street entrance to the end of Stage One, just before the Coral Street intersection.

Stage Two involves new paving, feature lighting, garden beds, street furniture, landscaping, public art and drainage.

Maintenance work will also be undertaken on the paving at the intersection of Ocean Street and Coral Street. This is planned to be undertaken during the Stage Two works to reduce local impacts.

Stage Two Project Delivery

Stage Two of the Mainstreet Precinct Upgrade will be delivered in three components with the aim of minimising the disruption to the Precinct.

Zone 1 – The eastern side of Ocean Street will be addressed first and take approximately 9 weeks (allowing on street car parking on the western side).

Zone 2 – Then the western side taking approximately 9 weeks (allowing car parking on the eastern side).

Zone 3 – Finally the middle road corridor, requiring complete road closure to vehicles from 19 August to 6 September 2019.

Works will start in early May 2019, and take approximately four months to complete (early September).

Accessing the Mainstreet

Pedestrian access will be made available at all times during business opening hours. There are several laneways that pedestrians can use to enter Ocean Street from McKinlay Street & Torrens Street during the works period.

To ensure your safety around the construction area, it is important to be aware of the signage and detours that are in place (for both pedestrians and motorists). Please obey the directions and stick to the designated areas.

Parking

There will be some impact on parking along the northern end of Ocean Street during the works. The map on this page shows a number of locations where alternative parking is available.
