

# Flourishing on the Fleurieu

*A festival that celebrates active ageing and showcases how our community flourishes*



**Flourishing on the Fleurieu is a regional festival that aims to promote health and wellbeing, and facilitate social connection among older people. In 2020, the festival is being held over two weeks from 17 to 30 October.**

**Applications are now being sought from community groups encouraging active participation of older people.**

## Guidelines

Grants are available to small community-based groups to support participation in the festival. The money can be used to fund an event or activity to encourage new people to get involved in a local community group. Activities could include a come and try day, a morning tea, a special one off event for the festival or any activity which encourages new people to get involved.

**A grant amount of \$150 is available to small community based groups.**

Events and activities will need to be held during the two week festival period, **17-30 October 2020.**

Eligible small community-based groups need to be located within one of the four council areas; Alexandrina, Victor Harbor, Yankalilla or Kangaroo Island and the event/activity should be aimed at encouraging older people to participate.

In assessing applications for funding, consideration will be given to events or activities that offer opportunities for new people to get involved.

**Applications close Monday, 1 June 2020.**

## How to apply

Successful and unsuccessful applicants will be advised in writing in early August. Grant funds will be provided to successful applicants in mid-September.

A program featuring the events and activities being hosted during the festival week will be available from each of the local council offices leading up to the festival.
