Dog On-lead and Off-lead Areas

Victor Harbor Dog Park

The Victor Harbor Dog Park (corner of George Main Road and Oval Park Road, Victor Harbor) is a designated off-lead area for dogs to play, socialise and exercise.

The dog park is open to the general public 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

24/7 on-lead areas

The Hindmarsh River Estuary sand dunes, Inman River Estuary sand dunes, and Wright Island (orange) are **new** areas where dogs must be on-lead at all times.

You must also continue to have your dog on-lead in these areas:

- Soldiers Memorial Gardens
- Soldiers Memorial Reserve
- Warland Reserve
- Petrel Cove
- Foreshore areas adjacent Encounter Lakes and Franklin Island (John Simmons Park, CM Thorpe Park, John Crompton Reserve)

On/off lead areas

During daylight savings (Oct to March):

- Between 10am–6pm: Dogs on lead.
- Between 6pm–10am: Dogs can be off-lead if under effective control by voice command and in close proximity to their owner.

Non daylight savings (April to Sept):

- Dogs can be off-lead if under effective control by voice command and in close proximity to their owner.
