

## The Hindmarsh River Walk

Length – 7 km Approximately Type - Loop Terrain - Easy

The Hindmarsh River Walk can be started at the Carpark at the end of Bridge Terrace or at the Carpark on Wattle Drive (see map). If starting at the end of Bridge Terrace. Walk across the railway line and over the foot bridge turn left and go under the bridge keep walking straight follow the path around until you get to Wattle Drive then go left and follow that until you get to the other Car park mark on the Map. Then keep walking



straight.

This picturesque walk follows the Hindmarsh River. The walk takes you through the Wattle Tree Avenue. Up through to Harry's Hole where a small swamp can be seen. Stand and listen awhile to watch the bird life and the frogs croaking in the background. Walk down the path a bit further and you'll come to a bridge.

The walk continues across the bridge. But you can go up the river a bit further following the track to the right; this takes you to Greenhill's Adventure Park. It's a scenic walk. You then have to come back to continue again; it's only an extra ten minutes.

Walk across the bridge and up the steps, to look over the valley. Once your on top turn left onto Waggon Road. Follow this until you reach Yalla-Doola Road. Turn left down it and follow it until you reach Castlemaine (a large white building). Turn down to you left and follow the track past Castlemaine until you come to the footbridge. Cross over the footbridge and walk up the hill. This is the Wattle Drive Carpark. If you've parked at the end of Bridge Terrace. Then Walk to the right, until you see Pearsons Drive. Walk down and around and you'll see the main footbridge back to your car.
