


COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT SUMMARY: JUNIOR SKATE FACILITIES

Introduction

The purpose of this report is to provide details of the community consultation undertaken in relation to Junior Skate Facilities in Victor Harbor. It outlines a summary of the consultation activities that were undertaken and the feedback gathered during the engagement period.

Background

The City of Victor Harbor aspires to be an inclusive and engaging City for young people to thrive in. Public facilities that specifically cater to young people, like scooter and skate tracks, can help to encourage socialisation, exercise and wellbeing.

While there are already scooter, skate and bike amenities in the Council area, the intent of a potential new junior skate facility would be to complement existing facilities and provide a safe, challenging and fun place for younger riders to enjoy in Victor Harbor.

Feedback and suggestions from the community were sought as they will help Council gauge interest in a junior skate facility and initiate planning for a potential park or track that can provide genuine benefit to youth in the community. Council was particularly interested in feedback relating to the best location for the park or track, possible design ideas, who the facility should cater for, and desired amenities for the park.

Consultation methodology

The community consultation period for Junior Skate Facilities ran from 9am on 30 March until 5pm on 23 April 2021.

The City of Victor Harbor collected the views of the community through a number of different methods including:

- Online survey available on Your Say website
- Online pin-dropping map tool available on Your Say website
- Hard copy survey available from Civic Centre
- Children's feedback sheet provided to Victor Harbor R-7 School and available in Victor Harbor Library
- School drop-in session Victor Harbor R-7 School, 9-11am on 9 April

The opportunity for residents and ratepayers to have a say about the strategic directions for the Community Plan was promoted in the following ways:

- Facebook post 30 March 726 people reached, 43 engagements
- Facebook post 13 April –1,799 people reached, 207 engagements
- Public notice The Times newspaper 1 April edition





Q. What best describes you?




Q. What is your age?



Q. Are you a parent or carer of someone who participates in scooter riding, skateboarding and/or bike riding?




Q. What activities do you and/or your children participate in the most?





TO build a better one with bigger ramps and pump tracks

The current skate parks (Foreshore and Oval) are severely outdated and are becomiing quite dangerous with gaps in the concrete forming creating ridges that can easily cause injury. The oval facilities are particularly inadequate and are rarely used by any rate-payers as a result. An upgrade to these facilites along with a new park is clearly required. Please do not build one of those modular pump tracks. They are a bad investment and not used much in any of the places I have seen them installed. What should be built is a skate 'bowl' simialr to what has been construted at Strathalbyn and Murray Bridge. The location at Hayborough would be ideal for this.


The proposed Junior Skate Park is definitely the missing piece to the Children's recreation area of Victor Harbor for those aged 4-10 years as they progress from playground eventually to the Youth Skate Park. It will allow parents to become involved with the education and training of their small children in the safe use of the scooter and at the same time have fun together. The JSPark will also alleviate the perceived "intimidation" factor by the big kids. It will also provide an educational training facility for school use for R - 7 children in road safety etc. The key to its success will be in it's location. I propose it be located close to the current playground (eastern side) thus allowing supervision of both the Junior Skate area and the "senior" playground surrounded by tables and chairs

Q. Where do you think would be the best place for installing future skate, scooter and bike riding facilities?





Responses to 'Other' included: Shade and seating; smaller bowl, hips, rails, etc; definitely some beginner and intermediate level areas. Something similar to Goolwa or Strathalbyn parks; Hard jumps; Flat ground space; Flat spaces to ride on; Wide long paths; Flat ground; Colourful detail, with mega ramps; Half pipe; Half pipe; Don't know; A skaterpark or bow. Any of the above would be an unwise investment; Ram and Easy beginner jumps on the new Junior Skate Pathway;

Q. Where would you like a junior skate park or track to go?

The old skate park is out dated without nothing to skate under 5ft. There needs to be something to skate for beginners around 3-4 foot. A bowl would be fantastic similar to Murray bridge. There is a great pump track at Goolwa but no good bowls locally. We drive our 3 boys to Adelaide almost every weekend to skate as Other councils in SA Have built or are building some excellent new parks. Skate park leagues hold competitions in each state around Australia, how good would it be to have this down south! Get on board Victor!

Children's Feedback Sheet

There were 78 children's feedback sheets completed.

School Drop-In Session

Some of the verbal feedback received during the Victor Harbor R-7 School drop-in session included:

- The Victor Harbor Oval BMX track and skate park was highlighted as being the current site most frequently used by students and that they would like to see upgraded/repaired.
- Suggestions in relation to the type of facilities were that making a large flat area for beginners would be good add smaller ramps to make facilities safer and less daunting.
- Some students were suggesting more and bigger ramps generally those who were confident riders.
- Many students identified the footpaths around their neighbourhood as being key destinations including the Encounter Bikeway.
- Kent Reserve was also highlighted as a place that many students visit with bikes and scooters and that it was already in good condition.
- Students were interested in the process of why they were providing feedback and why Council was seeking their input.

Students also took time to consider the location and completed a *Potential Locations Map* (26 completed) with further comment around sites, current use and what they would like to see happen.

Some of the quotes provided were:

"I use the Victor Harbor BMX track/skate park"

"Victor Harbor Skate Park I don't use"

"Kent Reserve is good but it is not a skate park"

"I've only used the Victor Harbor BMX track and I'd like to see lights and more trees there"

"Making a large flat area for beginners. Smaller ramps would make the park safer for children learning to skate, bike ride or scooter ride. Benches would make parents to watch their children. Lighting and a shaded area would improve the park too."

Ï think the VH BMX track needs to be re-done up and safer for younger skaters, bikers etc. It should also have benches lights table and other things that make the park better."

Ät Hayborough there is lots of room to add and build new things, there is already a track so adding some ramps, some benches would be really good and a great place to go"

Conclusion

In summary, community engagement was a useful process to help gain a better understanding of the needs for junior skate and scooter facilities in the Victor Harbor region. This broad, high level consultation will assist in progressing the improvement of junior skate and scooter facilities and ensure the needs of community are understood and considered as the project progresses to design.

The significant number of community positive responses demonstrates the importance of community input into decision making.

All comments provided as part of the engagement process will be presented to Council for further consideration.
